Born in Cable Head in 1818, MacIntyre was the third bishop of our diocese. He supported Catholic education on the Island by making improvements to St. Dunstan's College, and in the building of St. Patrick's School for boys in Charlottetown. This school later became Queen Square School. In concern for the health of the people, he pushed for the opening of the Charlottetown Hospital in 1879, the first one on the Island. Admission is by donation. St. Andrew's Chapel is 3km east of Mount Stewart.

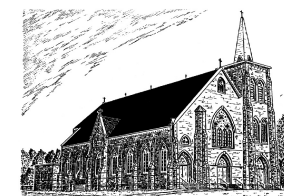


Please join us for our **Parish Family Picnic** on Sunday, July 22. Mass in the Church at 10:45am followed by a BBQ and dessert outdoors.
