May ~ *The Month to Honor Mary:*

All the pieces of the Marian Psalter had been brought together in the 12th century - the Hail Mary, the Our Father and the prayer beads. The Marian Psalter was intended as a spiritual weapon and an evangelical tool to conquer heresy and the devil. The Rosary was to be Mary's sword.

The Queen of Heaven, in 1208, chose St. Dominic as a founder and the father of a new way of praying the Marian Psalter. She revealed to him specific mysteries to meditate on while

praying the ten Hail Mary's. They focused on the Incarnation, The Passion and the Glorious Triumph of her divine son. She told St. Dominic that the reason he had obtained so little fruit by his labors, "You have spent



them on barren soil, not yet watered with the dew of divine grace. Therefore, preach my Psalter". That was the founding moment of the *holy rosary of Mary*. It was the moment her sword was unsheathed. After having been knighted by the Virgin with the *spiritual sword*, St. Dominic continued his preaching campaign with renewed fervor and won countless souls back to Christ and the Church.
