During this different and difficult period we are experiencing with COVID-19, when not everyone is able to make it to Sunday Mass due to maximum attendance limitations, Bishop Grecco has waived the obligation for Sunday Mass. Those unable to be present at a Sunday Mass are encouraged to attend a weekday Mass.

Singing at Masses: While we love to be able to sing and give God worship, public health has asked that, aside from a cantor or individual singer, we either refrain from singing or we sing in a low volume.

At Assumption, the rows of seats marked with **green tape** are **not to be used**. The **blue tape** has been removed from the available rows of seating. The Welcomers will assist in directing you to your seats. Whether attending Mass as an individual, a couple or a family, **you must leave four chairs (i.e. 6 feet) between different households**.

Inspired by the true story, the newly-released movie *Fatima* can be watched on-demand via Apple TV, YouTube, Bell, Rogers, and several other sources. This highly-acclaimed movie dramatizes the story of three young children and the Blessed Virgin Mary's appearances to them in Fatima, Portugal in 1917.
