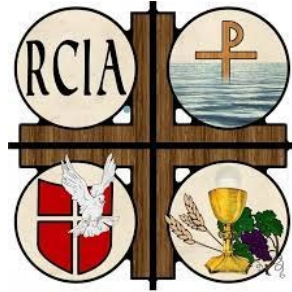
Have you ever desired to learn more about God?

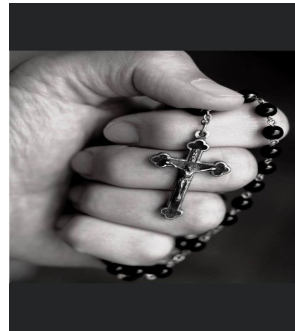


Beginning the week of September 25, weekday mass times will revert back to 10:00am.

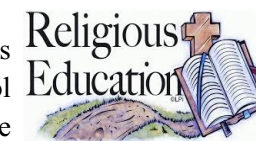
