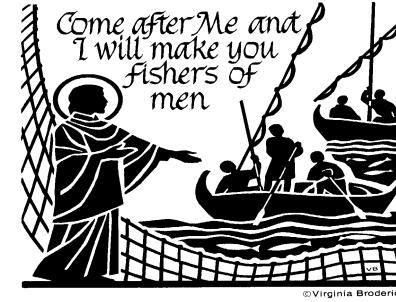

**CWL Annual Meeting:**

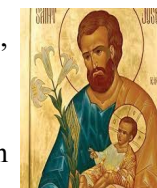
Sunday, January 22 - 2:00pm - Parish Hall
